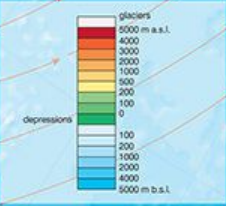

EXTREME POINTS OF EUROPE (marked)

- on the north: 71°08' N - Cape Nordkyn (Scandinavian Peninsula)
- on the east: 52°14' E - Bay of Biscay (Spain)
- on the south: 36°00' S - Cape Agulhas (Africa)
- on the west: 17°27' W - Cabo de Roca (Spain)

GEOGRAPHICAL RECORDS

- the highest peak: Mont Blanc (France, Italy) height: 4810 m a.s.l. (Caucasus Depression)
- the longest river: Volga (Russia, Kazakhstan) length: 3692 km (drainage basin: 1 350 000 km²)
- the biggest lake: Caspian Sea (Russia, Azerbaijan, Georgia) area: 371 000 km² (depth: 1025 m)
- the biggest peninsula: Iberian Peninsula (Spain, Portugal) area: 5 900 000 km²
- the biggest island: Great Britain (UK) area: 244 000 km²
